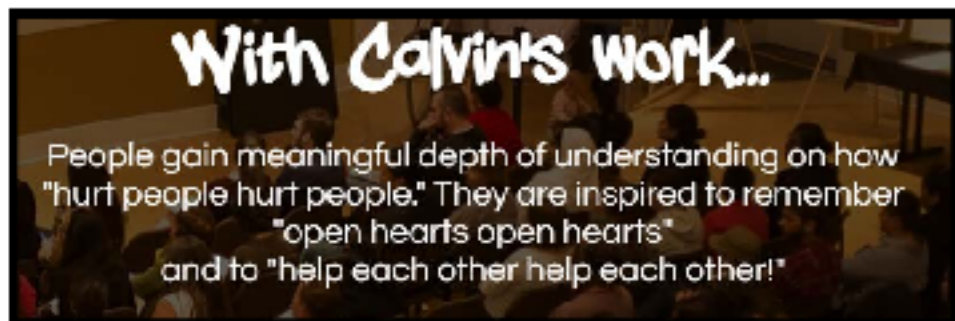


FEATURED SPEAKER
